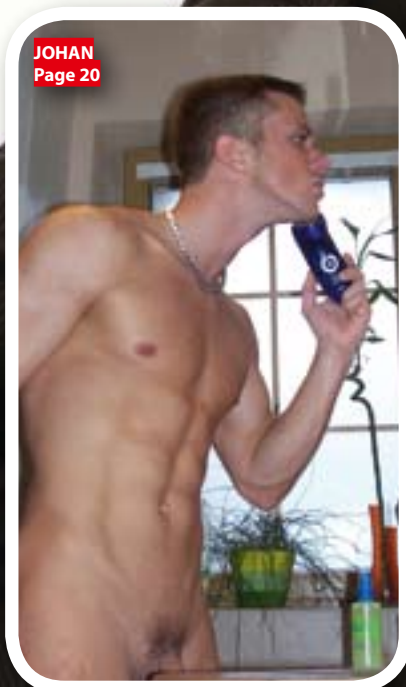

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EDITOR'S WORDS

Last month seemed very unreal to me, what with Clonezone going into receivership, Boy George going to prison and my holiday Euro now being worth more than a £.

I'm sure this is a worldwide problem but our little British pound is looking particularly vulnerable at the moment and budgeting for an overseas holiday is getting more difficult... that is if you can afford it in the first place.

The possible end to Clonezone is a great blow to all of us who grew up when the company first started. It offered a terrific 'gay beacon', an out-and-proud motif that was certainly needed all those years ago. The company was the first in many fields and the guys behind it wore their heart on their sleeves as they pushed their secret and what was regarded by some "offensive and subversive" shop from behind locked doors and onto the high street. In many ways CZ was a victim of its own success, growing and developing new lines and stores around the UK but, as many big names and brands have found to their cost in recent months, the credit crunch can, and has, hit hard. I wish them well and hope that they still manage to keep Clonezone going in some form or other.

According to the judge, drugs played an important part in Boy George's downfall from Pop Legend to another number at Her Majesties Pleasure. Even George's defence barrister added: "He will not now very likely ever be permitted to perform in the U.S and Japan where he has a very, very significant fan base. The humiliation of this is going to live with him for ever."

Meanwhile, in America they are still having the 'gay marriage' debate, which of course might become more of an issue now Barack Obama is President, as he's already signalled that he is against gay discrimination. 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RAPHAEL SOLOMON

TAKING OFF BIG TIME WITH MUSIC LOVING GAY AUDIENCES OVER THE POND IS 28 YEARS OLD, NIGERIA-BORN, FORMER MODEL BUT NOW WRITER/PRODUCER/PERFORMER RAPHAEL SOLOMON WHO KNOWS A LITTLE SOMETHING ABOUT LIFE, LOVE AND THE PURSUIT OF HAPPINESS.

Self-describing his sound as "pop with a Latin twist," the London transplant's music is based on those both basic and complex human emotions and experiences. Take "Sex With My Ex," for instance – the forthcoming first single from his debut album, *Beautiful Dancer*, now available on iTunes – which the artist penned after preparing a supper for, then seducing, a former flame.

"I planned the whole thing, like when you do when you're still in love with someone and you want them back," Solomon explains. "We didn't get back together, and instead of slashing my wrists, I wrote a song and gave it to myself as a Christmas gift."

Most of Solomon's songs, in fact – which he's been writing since the age of 7 – are steeped in similar soils. But it sort of comes with the territory, considering his background: born to Lebanese and Chilean, party-animal parents; relocating from one continent to another; and dating men and women while maintaining loving and sexual relationships with both sexes.

But the concept of love – or the lack thereof, on occasion – isn't just on what *Beautiful Dancer* is based. It's also on what the album was built. Especially when you consider that Solomon readily admits to "not having a penny to his name at times."

An independent artist through and through, Solomon financed the expensive studio time to record his record over a period of three years with jobs as a bartender, security guard and a male model. He recalls working as a retail assistant at a Harrod's department store too – where, he says, shoppers, on a daily basis, thought that having money was a warranty to talk down to people.

Rather than discourage him, this affluent attitude did just the opposite – it encouraged him to continue pursuing his passion while providing even more material to work with, the result of which is "Rich in My Heart," another of the album's grinding gems.

With all this talk of heartbreak, however, don't assume that Solomon doesn't have a sense of humor. He's not the kind of cat content with licking old wounds. Instead, he prefers to pick himself up, dust himself off, and – when he's not writing or recording those chapters in his life – have a little fun.

Just like the night he became the king of more than a few people's jungles.

"I once went onstage dressed as Tarzan, and 20 seconds into my number my loincloth came undone," he recalls. "That was a very memorable experience for both the audience and me!"

But, then again, maybe that faux pas was all part of Solomon's grander scheme: "To entertain, to be identifiable, and to be recognized as an artist who can be related to on a personal level."

WITH POP FIRMLY BACK IN THE CHARTS THERE SEEMS TO HAVE BEEN A RISE IN GIRL BANDS IN THE LAST TWELVE MONTHS, BUT WHO REALLY ARE THE QUEENS OF POP? SIMON SAVIDGE LOOKS AT WHERE IT ALL STARTED AND WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?



In a recent survey with One Poll - Girls Aloud were announced as the best girl group of all time with the shocking result that the Spice Girls came in second. ► **LILY ALLEN**

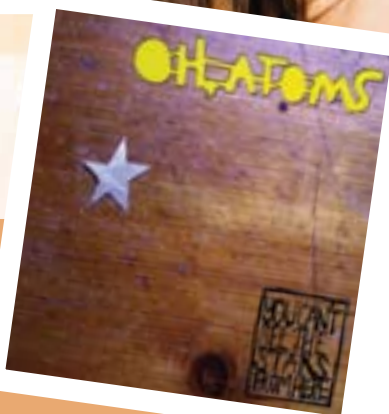
It's Not Me, It's You

Grunge started some twenty years ago in the US, and now the Fleet Foxes demonstrate how much has changed in that time. Fleet Foxes play what they call 'baroque harmonic pop jams', which belies their folksy, slightly intoxicated sound and carefully orchestrated vocal harmonies. Songs such as 'White Winter Hymnal' evoke the transcendent beauty of the spiritual with the pop tastiness of the Beach Boys. Stirred into this rock mixing pot is everything from English folk songs to the Byrds, providing a nice antidote to the commercial functionalism of 'cool' indie bands like Arcade Fire.

Influences as varied as Daft Punk, Nina Simone and Led Zeppelin collide in this album, which perhaps heralds the beginning of a new musical genre. Their debut single, 'Last Night' is already popular on the club scene because of its fusion of genres, and with this album they hope to make their mark and stay put as genre-bending music-maestros extraordinaire.

YOU DON'T GET MORE GANGSTA THAN SEAN FOREMAN AND NATHANIEL MOTTE - TWO NATIVES OF BOULDER, COLORADO, THE NATION'S CAPITAL OF HIPPIES, HEMPWEAR AND HUMMERS.

They first connected when they discovered they had a mutual man-crush on Buck 65 (a Canadian who is on the radio over there) in their University of Colorado physics class, 3OH!3 have been packing out clubs with their hip-hop hardness, electro eroticism and 80s pop pabulum. Their Photo Finish/Atlantic records debut 'WANT' - which will be out in the UK later this year, and sees our heroes Nathaniel Motte and MC Sean Foreman unleashing tongue-in-cheek rhymes and beats that incorporate '80s pop, electronica, and crunk hip-hop to deliver a knockout punch. 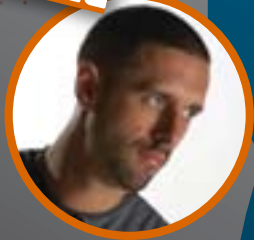
Imagine you have this weekend off! How would you spend Saturday night?

That was when I started DJing 13 years ago. I had taken my first E and I passed out behind the DJ booth, broke all needles on the decks and my records. The club was packed with 2000 clubbers and the music just stopped and I was carried out. Very embarrassing

Bob Sinclar, Sandy Rivera, Master at Works and Frankie Knuckles have all graced the label and helped them forge their unique blend of soul, funk and disco. A personal favourite here at Bent is Roger Sanchez' "Another Chance" (the vocals were sampled from a little known rock ballad called "I Won't Hold You Back" by Toto from 1982) which gave the label it's first UK number 1 back in 2001.

3. Blaze ft Barbara Tucker - Most Precious Love

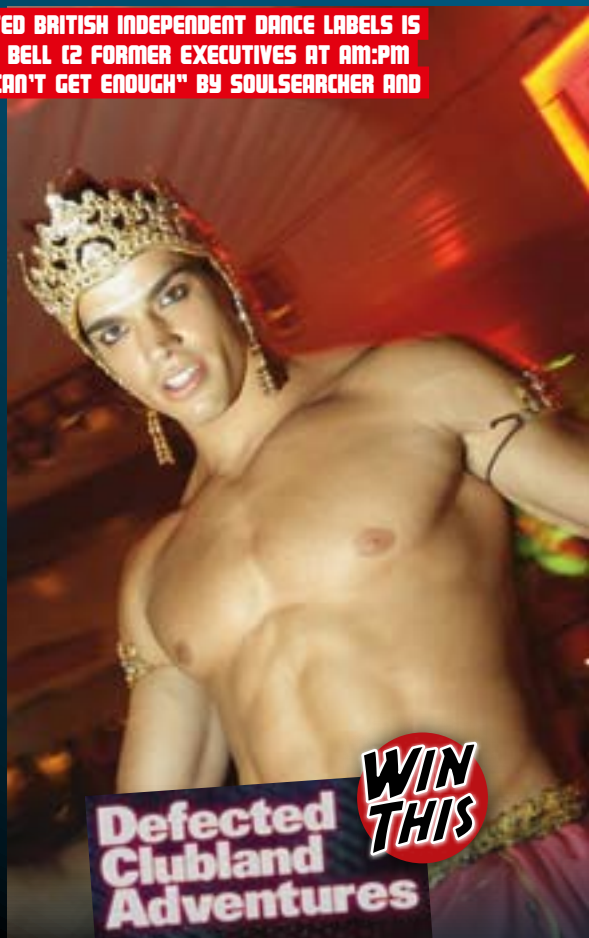

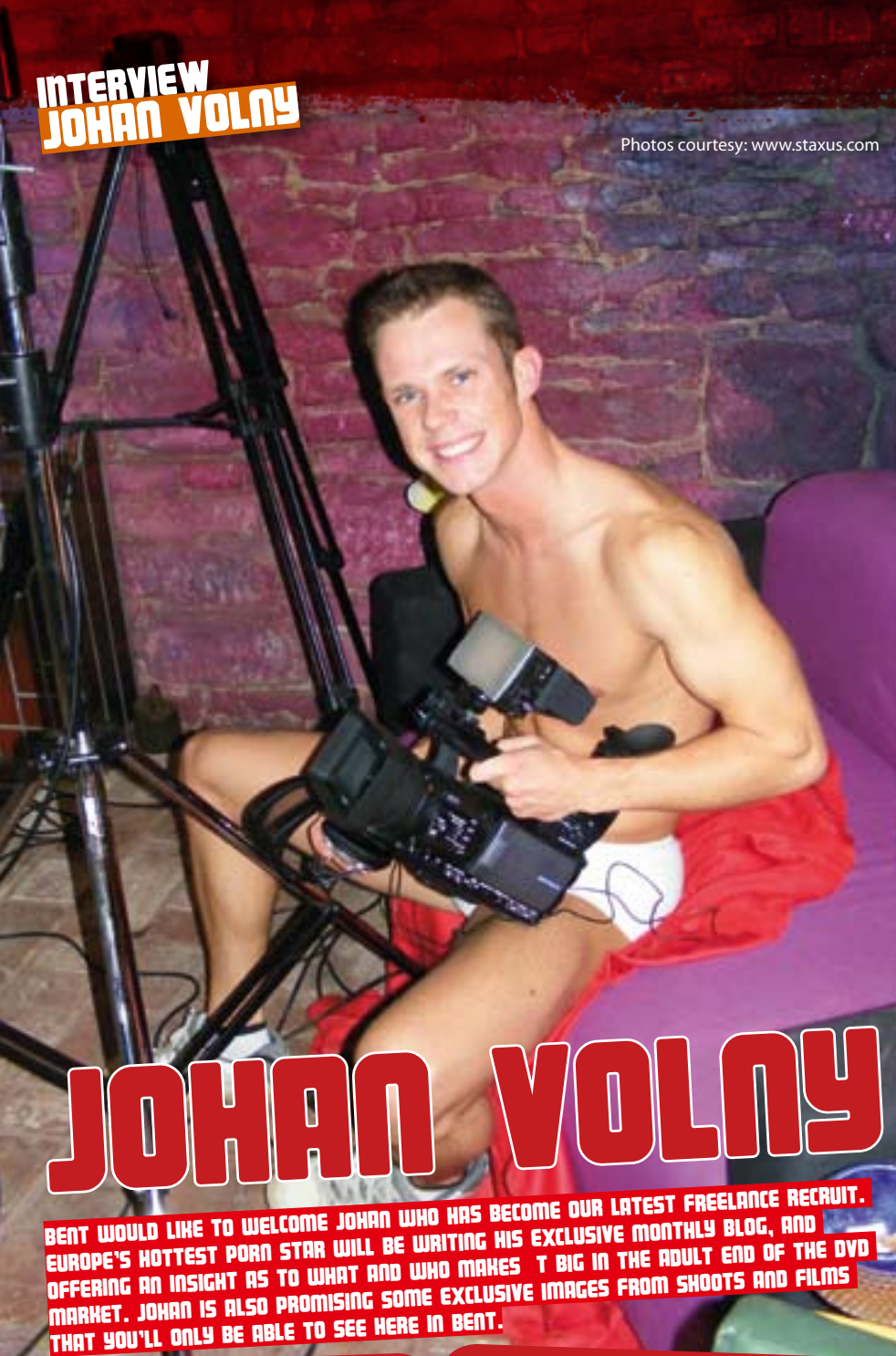

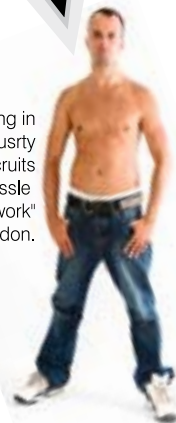

Singer and highly rated club DJ Boy George, who was convicted of falsely imprisoning a male escort in his flat in Shoreditch, east London, has been jailed for 15 months.

The 47-year-old, who was charged under his real name George O'Dowd, was found guilty in December of handcuffing male escort Audun Carlsen to a radiator and beating him with a chain during a drug-fuelled photoshoot.

Judge David Radford told the former Culture Club frontman he was guilty of "gratuitous violence" and went on to say that O'Dowd's drug-fuelled actions were "premeditated", "callous", and "degrading" which "traumatised" his victim.

Mr Carlsen testified that he was manacled to the bed, but managed to escape and ran from the flat wearing only his boxer shorts, trainers and a pair of handcuffs.

The news that one of the world's largest gay retail chains has gone into administration came as a great surprise to everyone. Recently, a group of 11 people were charged with indecent chanting following a match between Portsmouth and Tottenham Hotspurs. What in fact they were doing was shouting homophobic abuse at Sol Campbell, who now plays for Portsmouth but who used to be the Spurs captain. Such chanting is prevalent around most grounds in the UK and it is to the Football Association's credit that they took some of Peter Tatchell's advice to bring out a DVD condemning such acts, which can be shown in schools. Some football manager's are convinced that they have no homosexual players on their team and even that homosexuals could not play at such a high level as the Premiership or Italy's Serie A. However, an Italian man has claimed that up to 30 top-flight footballers have paid him for sex. In an interview on TV station La 7 the man, who plays football in the lower leagues, claimed:

"I have about 30 clients who are footballers and I would say that a dozen are Serie A and national team players - several times I have been asked to take part in group sex sessions. They all know I am a footballer as well but they like me because I am discreet."

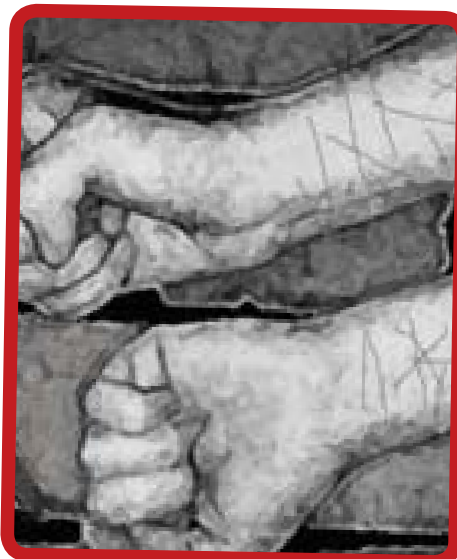
The third division player turned rent boy, who identified only as Victory, claimed he is paid 1500 euros (£1300) for his services, but did not name any of his alleged clients.

Having said that, until a high-profile player does come out, the delusions that it doesn't exist and that it is a 'manly' sport, only played and enjoyed by heteros will, unfortunately continue.

SUPPORT FOR SELF HARM

Self Harm is a growing problem among young people in the UK, with recent research showing one in 15 are self-harming. The problem is common among gay, bisexual, and transgender men and women, who have been identified as a vulnerable group. A new, unique, online resource for young people affected by self-harm has been launched in response to increasing rates of self-harm in the UK, as identified in the report of the National Inquiry into self-harm among young people 'Truth Hurts'. The Inquiry found that one in 15 young people in the UK had self-harmed, and identified a need for 'much better web-based information on self-harm. In response, youth mental health charity 42nd Street, youth homelessness charity Depaul UK and online communications charity YouthNet, have worked with a group of young people affected by self-harm to create a 'place' online where other young people (aged 16-25) can access high quality information, resources and support on the issue.

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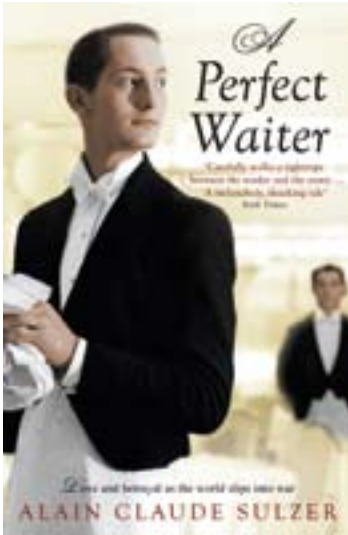
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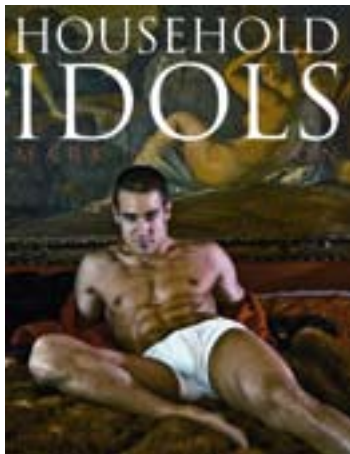
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▶ **A PERFECT WAITER – ALAIN CLAUDE SULZER**

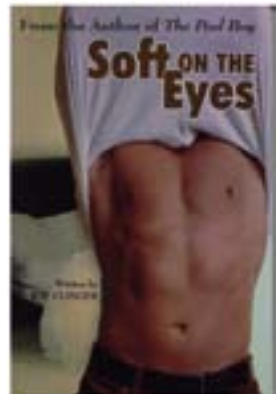

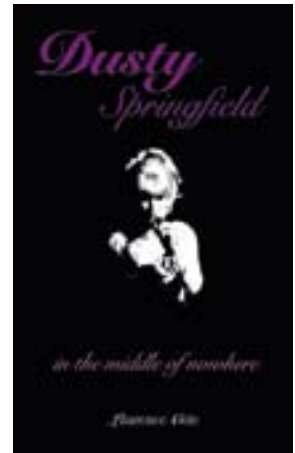

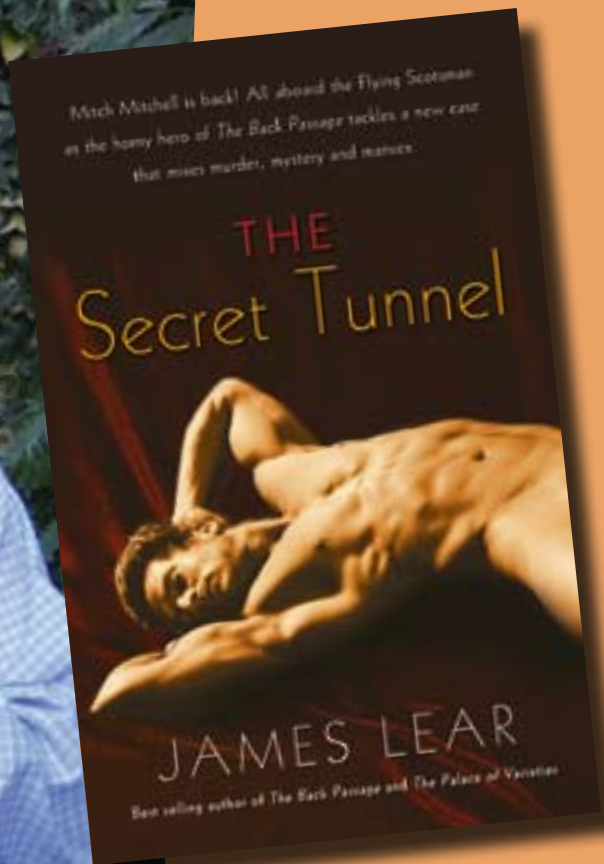

He added that it was important for him to learn about the story of Milk - who was the first openly gay man to be elected into major public office in America.

"I grew up in Palo Alto which is 45 minutes way from San Francisco (where Milk lived) and I was born in 1978 the year Harvey Milk was assassinated and when I heard about the movie I did a little research... and I was shocked and sad that nobody had told me anything about Milk.

"It was kind of crazy that growing up in the area that I wouldn't know anything about him," he said.

It's 1964, St. Nicholas in the Bronx. A charismatic priest, Father Flynn (Philip Seymour Hoffman), is trying to upend the schools' strict customs, which have long been fiercely guarded by Sister Aloysius Beauvier (Meryl Streep), the iron-gloved Principal who believes in the power of fear and discipline. The winds of political change are sweeping through the community, and indeed, the school has just accepted its first black student, Donald Miller. But when Sister James (Amy Adams), a hopeful innocent, shares with Sister Aloysius her guilt-inducing suspicion that Father Flynn is paying too much personal attention to Donald, Sister Aloysius sets off on a personal crusade to unearth the truth and to expunge Flynn from the school. Written and directed by John Patrick Shanley based on his own play, the dialogue is razor sharp, which the actors clearly relish this and giving incredible performances.

◀ ANVIL! THE STORY OF ANVIL

Out: 20th February

A hit at last year's Sundance Film Festival, *Anvil! The Story of Anvil* has subsequently gone on to pick up awards around the world. *Anvil! The Story of Anvil* stars real-life members of the band, Steve "Lips" Kudlow and Robb Reiner. As 14 year-old school friends, they promised to rock together forever. Their band, Anvil, went on to become the "demigods of Canadian metal," releasing one of the heaviest albums in metal history, 1982's *Metal on Metal*. But Anvil's career took a different path - straight to obscurity. Picking up on their story 26 years later, director Sacha Gervasi (writer of *The Terminal*), who worked as a roadie for the band when he was 16, uncovers an achingly touching and often hilarious account of Anvil! is much more, an incredibly raw, candid, heartbreaking and truly inspirational story.

Heath Ledger had a miserable time on the *Brokeback Mountain* set - because director Ang Lee treated the late star like an "alienated prop", according to the film's producer James Schamus. In an Entertainment Weekly magazine tribute piece - marking the first anniversary of Ledger's death - Schamus explains, "During casting, rehearsals, and pre-production, Ang (Lee) is like the warm, wise, cuddly daddy bear. The minute he yells 'Action' on the first shot, the actors become alienated props he kind of puts up with... It's tough on actors." Meanwhile, it has been revealed Heath was film bosses' first choice to play Spider-man.

Former *Ally McBeal* star Portia De Rossi reveals she and her wife Ellen De Generes went meat and dairy-free late last year, admitting she and her wife have been working towards becoming vegans since their very first date.

Actor Chris Noth is convinced plans for a *Sex And The City: The Movie* sequel will come to fruition - because studio bosses are eager to cash in on the box office success of the first film. Noth's on-screen love interest, Sarah Jessica Parker, confirmed in November there will be a follow-up to the hit big screen adaptation of the longrunning U.S. TV show - after the first movie grossed over £275 million last summer.

Bosses of medical drama *E.R.* have left the door open for George Clooney to make an appearance in the show's final episode. Clooney starred as Dr. Doug Ross from 1994 to 1999 in the long running series. And now the show is coming to an end after 14 years, TV executives hope Clooney will make time in his busy schedule to stop by and make a surprise cameo in the two-hour finale, which is planned for March.

Hairspray creator John Waters has been forced to scrap plans for a new children's movie - after studios rejected it. The filmmaker last year announced his plans to make a kids Christmas movie starring Johnny Knoxville. He described the film, to be titled *Fruitcake*, as "Little Rascals on acid". But the movie has been axed, and Waters is blaming the economy, and unpredictable studio executives.

Lesbian TV drama *The L Word* is set for a prison-based spin-off, featuring former Bond girl Famke Janssen. The final season of the show premiered last month in the U.S., but producers are already planning a follow-up show.

Star Trek veteran George Takei has jumped ship and will voice a role in Star Wars TV spin-off *The Clone Wars*. The Heroes actor and British reality TV star will portray nuclear warlord Lok Durd in an upcoming episode of the animated sci-fi series. He tells TV Guide magazine, "I was cast as a grotesquely obese guy in Disney's *Mulan*, and now again in *Clone Wars*. I just love the way the new (George) Lucas animation technology makes my fat jiggle."

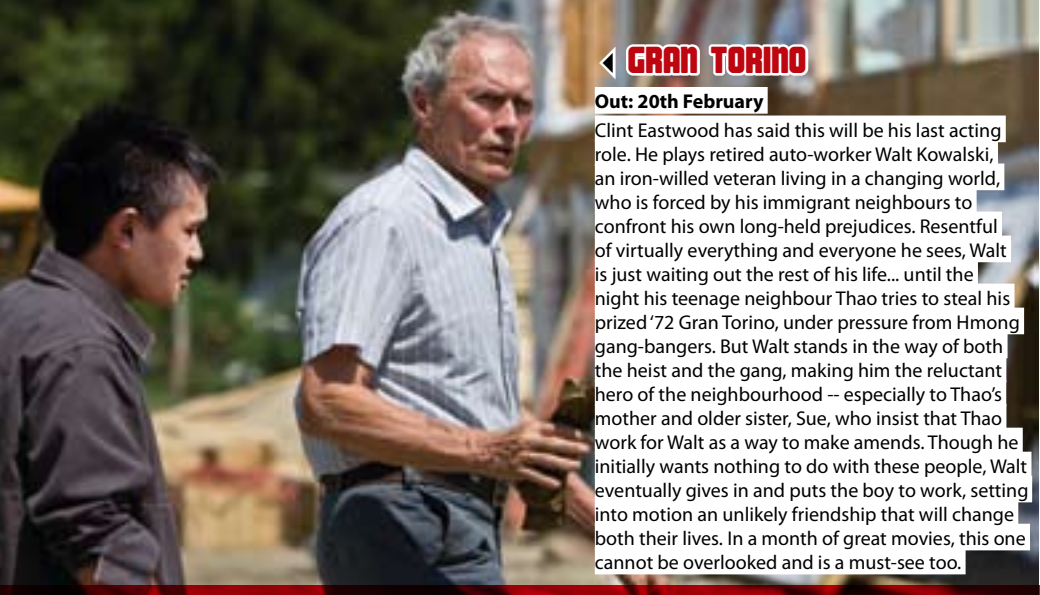

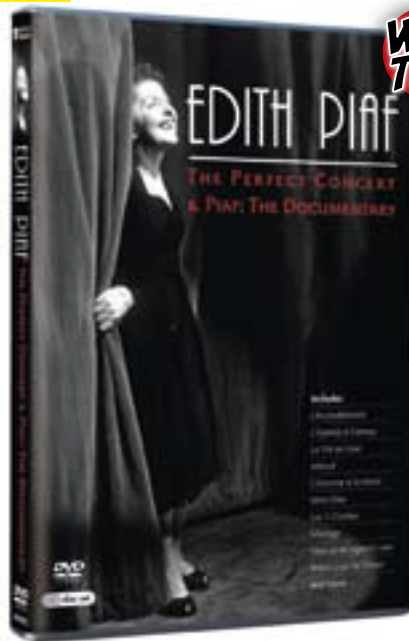

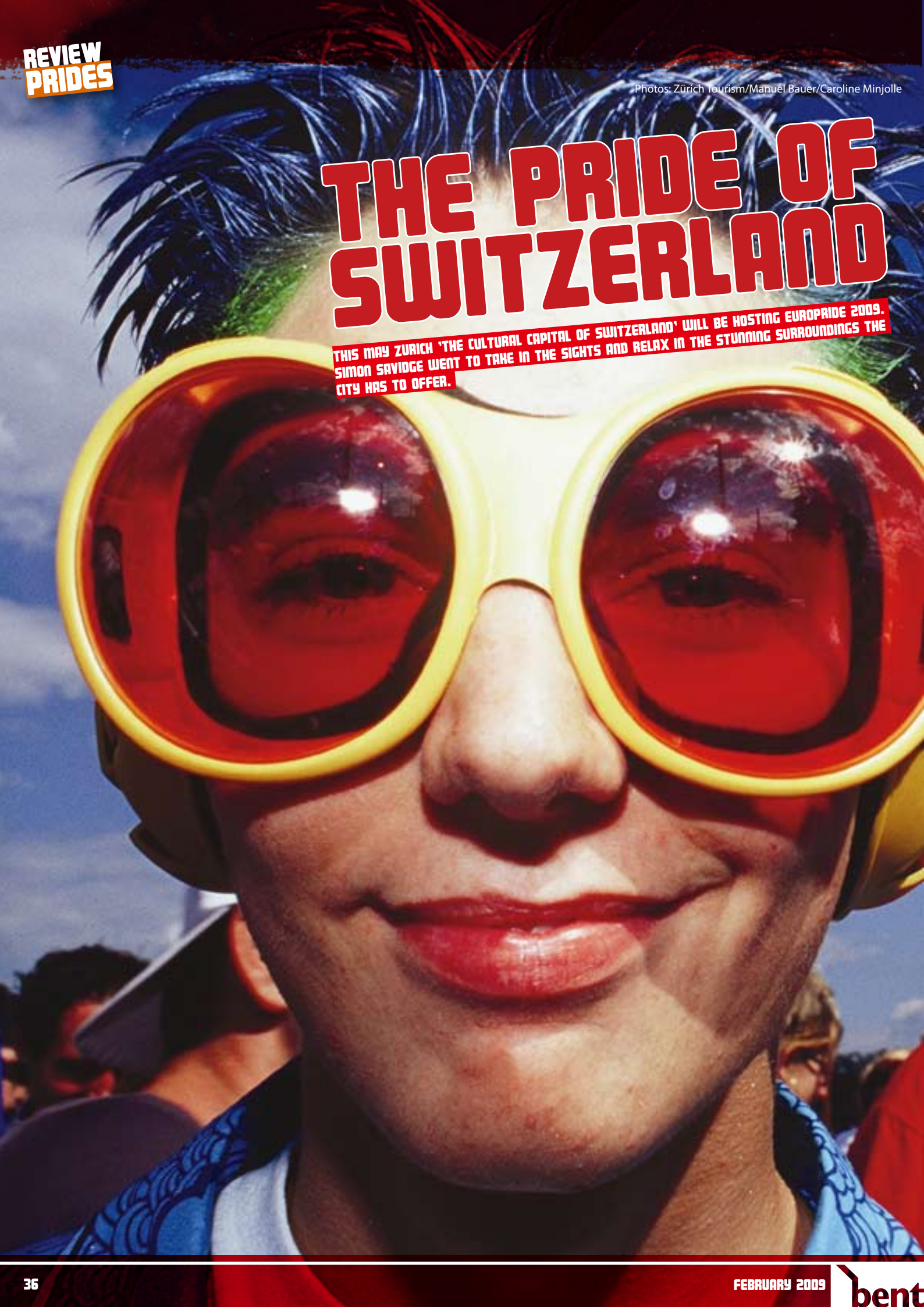

Norwich is bootiful, really bootiful. Not just the city itself, which is indeed a kind of overlooked York - out-on-a-limb in the oft forgotten lobe of East England, complete with castle, cathedral, walls, arches like some rare breed medieval saintly and trade street names! But also: the home-grown males in this town full-swollen by students, all strutting stuff around its ancient, compact, easily walkable lanes like some rare breed sure to broaden the smile on even one of Bernard Matthews' jolliest faces!

Sights

The regional capital that is Norwich is, arguably, the most complete medieval city in Britain - boasting over 1,500 historic buildings - albeit now imbued with a truly modern vibe.

Be inspired by Norwich Cathedral, sporting the largest cloisters, and second tallest spire, in England - not to mention its picturesque adjoining Close; get lost in the warren of medieval alleys lined with small speciality boutiques in the Lanes - contrasting nicely with the city's more

modern precincts; admire attractive half-timbered houses, most notably along the cobbled Elm Hill; explore the 12th Century Norman Castle now housing the county's main museum, brimming with local historic treasures.

Just below the Castle, snap up a bargain at the refurbished open-air market - England's largest, with stalls selling a wide range of goods, six days a week; visit some of the 30+ medieval churches within the city walls alone, many converted to other uses now - such as Norwich Puppet Theatre, or Norwich Arts Centre, with its nice little eatery; take in a show at the Playhouse or Theatre Royal.

The Norman Foster-designed Sainsbury Centre UEA (www.scva.ac.uk) boasts a truly world-class collection - with a particularly fine line in major works by Moore, Bacon and Giacometti. Awesome.

Scene

Step back in time! Stay at gay-beckoning Gothic House B&B

(Old King's Head Yard, Magdalen Street; T: 01603 631879; www.gothic-house-norwich.com) - a boutique Grade II-listed 1820-built gem, the interior charmingly reeking of history, overseen by character Clive and cat Tensing.

Feeling peckish? Delia's (Norwich City Football Club, Carrow Road; T: 01603 218705; www.deliascanarycatering.co.uk/restaurant.php), at the footie ground just south of centre, is the only restaurant in the world dedicated exclusively to the "canary cuisine" of Norwich's most famous daughter.

Stomach filled, hit new girl The Catherine Wheel (61 St Augustine's; T: 01603 827852; [w: www.inthewheel.com](http://www.inthewheel.com)) - a lively homo haunt just north of centre, its olde, exposed Tudor-meets-Soho rafters and timbers fair-shaking with queer quizzes, plus crazy karaoke and creaky dragged-up cabaret.

To step things up a gear, march east to storm The Castle (Spitalfields, off Ketts Hill; T: 01603 768 886; www.thecastle-pub.com) - its dance space, The Barn, opening around 10pm cum weekends.



THE BROADS & GREAT YARMOUTH

Across the wildlife-teeming waterways of the Norfolk Broads, a pleasant 20 mile train trek due east of Norwich, lies Great Yarmouth. And the sea.

En route, take in The Broads themselves! Explore Fairhaven Woodland and Water Garden (www.fairhavengarden.co.uk), with its plants, shrubs, ancient trees, birds, dykes, gift shop, modern café-tea room plus vast private broad affording fab boat trips! Visit Ranworth Church - just up the road from South Walsham - to climb the tower and get a great view of surrounding wetlands, before walking out to the Norfolk Wildlife Trust's floating info centre on Ranworth Broad (www.norfolkwildlifetrust.org.uk).

And so onto Great Yarmouth itself! Fresh air, long sandy, dunny beaches, craft and "herring" heritage, funfair entertainment, theatres, piers, shops and markets await! Gawp at the history of its preserved old town walls, row houses and quays. Explore the town's links with the likes of Dickens and Nelson!

Stay at family-run, yet gay-wooding Imperial Hotel (North Drive, Great Yarmouth; T: 01493 842000; www.imperialhotel.co.uk) - a historic lodging overlooking dune and wave with fine Café Cru restaurant.

The local gay scene means the vibrant yet still loungey King's Wine Bar (42 King Street, Great Yarmouth; T: 01493 85374), just back from the front - open all day 'til midnight and beyond.

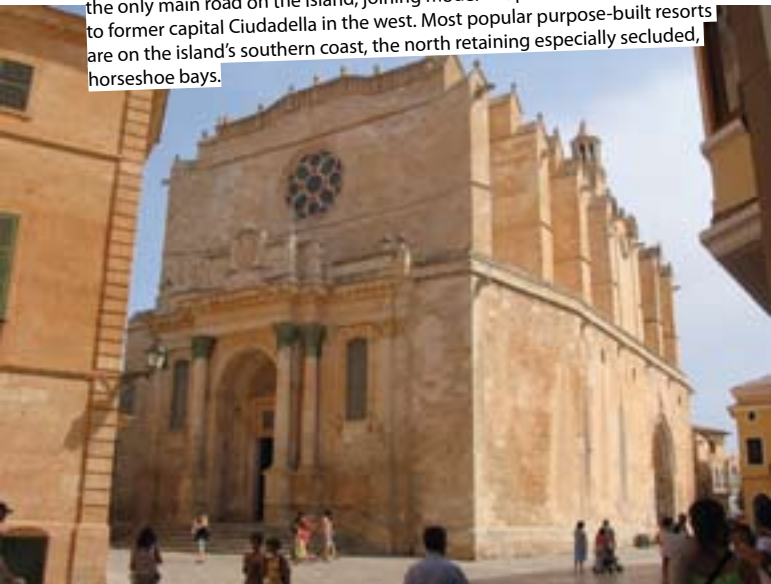

MEN ON MENORCA!

LOVED MALLORCA? SEEN IBIZA? ADRIAN GILLAN SAMPLES THAT OTHER BEAUTIFUL BALEARIC: LITTLE MENORCA!

Second largest of the Spanish Balearic Islands, Menorca sparkles in the Mediterranean Sea, off the east coast of mainland Spain - 2 hours' flying time from most UK airports; one hour ahead of GMT on arrival. Despite the onset of mass tourism in the 60's, Menorca - with its mere 90,000 populous - still remains relatively "unspoilt" compared to its noisier neighbours. The ME1 is the only main road on the island, joining modern capital Mahon in the east to former capital Ciutadella in the west. Most popular purpose-built resorts are on the island's southern coast, the north retaining especially secluded, horseshoe bays.



TO STAY

Hotel Port Ciutadella (Paseo Marítimo 36, Ciutadella; T: +34 971 482 520; www.sethotels.com) - This chic, modern 4* spa hotel lies on the west coast of the island in the charming town of Ciutadella, former capital - on the seafront, close to the bijou Platja Gran beach and town centre!

Hotel Port Mahon (Avenida del Port Mahon, Mahon; T: +34 971 362 600; www.sethotels.com) - Situated on the east coast, in a quiet residential area overlooking present-day capital Mahon's massive natural harbour, this 4* colonial-style hotel is just five minutes stroll from the town centre!

ApartHotel Bahia Park (Calle Llebbeig 16, Cala'n Porter; T: +34 971 377 246; bahiapark@bmc-hotels.com) - This 3* "straight-friendly" self-catering apartment complex in due to open, May 2009.

TO SEE 'N DO

Ciutadella - Ciutadella was the original capital of Menorca until the Brits came along and moved it to Mahon in the 18th Century. But it still remains the spiritual centre. The café-lined harbour and marina is one of the smallest ports in the Mediterranean - best viewed from the main square, Plaça des Born, itself dominated by the town hall. The nearby old town warren boasts a 14th Century cathedral, a seminary and fish market. Bask on cute Platja Gran "inner city" beach.

Mahon (a.k.a. Maó) - Situated at the island's easternmost point, Mahon is Menorca's most densely populated town. The Brits made it an administrative hub in the 18th Century and it has remained the capital ever since. Check out the town hall with its "British" clock; cloistered café-lined market; old city gate ruins; and plethora of fish eateries and millionaires' yachts lining the vast harbour below.

The "other" towns - You have to drive through Ferreries, Es Mercadal and Alaior as you cross the island anyway, so you might as well stop off... and be charmed!

Mount Toro - Menorca's highest "peak" (357m) offers great all-round vistas on a clear day.

Nature - A UNESCO-protected wilderness and wetlands lies north of Mahon, brimming with birds.

Secluded sandy coves - Such idylls include Cala Galdana, plus nearby Cala Macarella and Cala Macarelleta, both well-nigh virgin; Cala en Porter; and Binisafúller.

Beach and dune - Stroll lengthy Son Bou beach 'n dune system, in the middle of the south coast.

Castles - East of Mahon, explore old Brit haunt, Fort Marlborough; plus infamous La Mola.

Ancient stone remains - Scattered across the island, some sites date back to around 1500 BC.

Cova d'en Xoroi - This vast bar-club at Cala en Porter is built into cliff caves high above the sea, which its balconies gaze down upon. Once a pirate dive, now a great place to watch the sun set.

TO BOOZE 'N CRUISE

There are no gay-specific bars on Menorca, but Akelarre (Moll de Ponent 41-43, www.akerarrejazz.es), Ars (Plaza Principe 12, www.arscafe.info) and Nou (Carrer Nou) are especially gay-friendly and mixed, in Mahon. In Ciutadella, try Jazzbar (Marina). Beyond which, gents oft "take airs" at and along...

Lofty Passeig Maritim, Mahon

Son Bou beach - the dunes get busy; and the westernmost beach section is unofficially nudist.

Cala Macarelleta - another staggeringly beautiful unofficial nudist beach, reached by a 20 minute walk from Cala Macarella, itself a pleasant 30 minute walk from Cala Galdana. Pine forest to rear!

COCKY OPERATION

THE CENTRE IS ONE OF THE FIRST IN THE UK TO OFFER PENIS ENLARGEMENT TREATMENTS. Macrolane has traditionally been used for breast-augmentation in what the tabloids call the '30-minute boob job'. The same procedure, however, can be used safely on the penis too. Macrolane is an entirely biodegradable product comprising hyaluric acid, which is a plumping compound found naturally in the skin. Injecting the Macrolane solution to the penis requires only local anaesthetic.

The procedure is simple. The patient receives a local injection to the base of the penis, which serves to numb the entire area. Then smaller doses of anaesthetic are applied around the shaft to the areas where the injections will be made. Usually the doctor has up to five syringes full of Macrolane, totalling 50ml of the fluid. This is injected strategically to provide a natural-looking increase in the girth of the penis. Effects are immediate as the penis can literally be seen expanding as the procedure is carried out. Sometimes not all the 50ml is injected at once, as the Macrolane takes two weeks to set. Once the Macrolane has set, the patient must return to the clinic for a check-up to see how the penis looks. If at this point the penis needs more girth or additional contouring, extra Macrolane is injected in a quick 10-minute top-up operation. This should then resolve any lopsidedness or unevenness to the penis, resulting in a smooth, natural-to-the-touch penis visibly bigger than before.

The added weight of the Macrolane also works to make the penis look longer, as it will hang lower and heavier than it did before. And because the injections do not restrict bloodflow, your penis will get a further increase in size when you get an erection, although the increased size of your flaccid penis may make the growth less dramatic. One important point to note is that the glans or helmet cannot be increased in size, so the girth may have to be skillfully tapered by the surgeon in order to achieve an organic appearance.

The texture of the Macrolane is natural, unlike silicone implants, meaning the flaccid penis feels almost identical before and after. When erect, the shaft is slightly squidgier in texture, but the result is still natural and undetectable. Furthermore, if the result isn't to your liking, the body usually absorbs the Macrolane in 12-24 months, depending on lifestyle circumstances, so you can return to your previous penis size eventually if you desire. Of course, you'll probably love the result, and it can be topped up annually. Furthermore, because the procedure is relatively painless and quick, you can have it done in your lunchtime and return straight to work afterwards.

Costs for the treatment start at £1,600 with reduced rates for annual top-ups to maintain girth.

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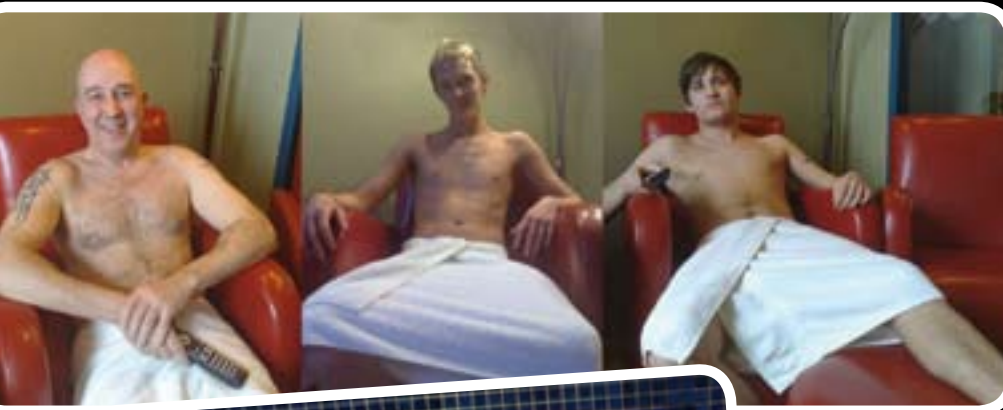
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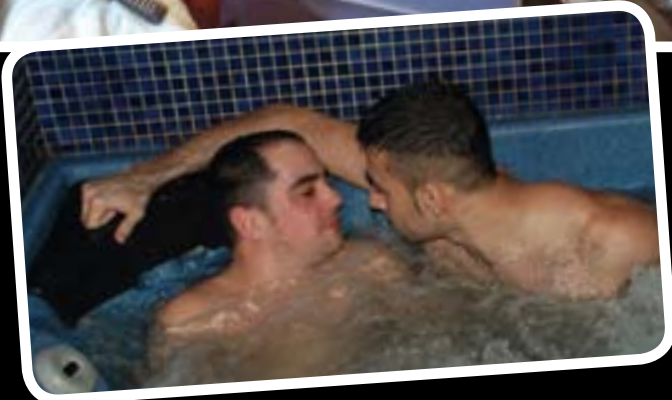
