Michael Joseph Jackson 1958 - 2009



Just weeks before his much heralded appearance at London's o2 Arena for a series of comeback concerts, pop star Michael Jackson has died in Los Angeles, aged 50.

Rumours that rehearsals weren't going well because of health issues had been circulating for many weeks but were denied by the Jackson camp, even after

he had to postpone some of the early dates of the sell-out shows in the capital

At the time of going to press information on the exact cause of death is sketchy. It is believed that the star collapsed and despite attempts by his personal physician and paramedics attempts at CPR they were unable to revive him. After being transferred from his home to the UCLA medical centre he was pronounced dead, it was believed he suffered a cardiac arrest.



Michael had a stunning and unique career. Even at a young age his vocal talents were breathtaking and his style embodied a soul and a teen appeal that his record company Motown were keen to capitalize on. In the 70s. and at the tender age of 11, he was fronting a band of his sibling brothers, the Jackson 5 who became worldwide phenomenon chalking it many hits including "I Want You Back", "ABC" and "Can You Feel It".

Later, he began to carve out a solo career and when he teamed up with master producer Quincy Jones the stage was set for a record breaking convergence of talent that produced the biggest selling pop album of all time, Thriller. The music, the imagery, the dancing, the production, the timing... everything just clicked and the man was elevated from superstar to global megastar status.

While his musical genius was going from strength to strength, his personal life became mired in suspicion and controversy. His relationship with a 13 year-old boy he had befriended ended when he was accused of child sexual abuse. The subsequent court case and publicity hounded Jackson for the rest of his career as others came forward with similar claims. The media, sensing famous blood would be spilled, continued digging for more stories, both true and false, with which to bring down this global musical

prodigy. As a result, his health suffered his actions became more bizarre and he became a recluse, only venturing out in various forms of disquise.

Despite all the gossip and innuendo, Jackson married twice. Once to the daughter of his musical hero Elvis Presley and later to his nurse, Deborah Jeanne Rowe, with whom he fathered a son, Michael Joseph Jackson, Jr. (also known as "Prince"), and a daughter, Paris Michael Katherine Jackson. Later a third child, known affectionately as Blanket, was also born, believed to be through artificial insemination although the mother remains unidentified.

During his extraordinary career, he sold an estimated 750 million records worldwide, released 13 No. 1 singles and became one of a handful of artists to be inducted twice into the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame. The Guinness Book of World Records recognized Jackson as the Most Successful Entertainer of All Time he also won 13 Grammy Awards and received the American Music Award's Artist of the Century Award.

At a press conference in March when he announced his return to the stage and the series of concerts in London he said how much he was looking forward to giving his fans what they wanted; the music, the dancing, the sheer showmanship that made had Michael Jackson famous in the first place. The fans, who always supported Jackson, snapped up 750000 tickets in days. Many people from around the world desperate to see the star, maybe for the final time, take to the stage once again. It is with a great deal of sadness that the public, who loved him so much, will never get the opportunity to show just how much they believed in him.

The king of Pop is dead... and there will never be another like him.

But there's so much more to the lad... and... as it's been a while since Bent got to chat with this sexy hunk, we decided to put our feet up and have a good natter (and a good drool).

So what have you been up to since we last saw you?

Um, that depends when you last saw me. I've mostly been working really hard to finish my new album Moxie in the most recent months. Prior to that I lived in Williamsburg, Brooklyn, for a short time and toured some of the States, where I shot my new music video, 'Coming Out 2 Play'. I'm also still involved in a workshop programme aimed at year 10 students at secondary schools in Wales, breaking down their stereotypes of gay culture and make them more aware of homophobia and bullying. We are hoping to expand that over the next year to include as many schools in the UK as possible.

There's a bit of a change to your sound here. Why?

My early work was mostly produced by other people and I really entered from the militant hip-hop angle—always something to say! [He laughs gently.] Now I solely produce my own material and my own sound has emerged, leaning towards fidget and electro house and pop. It features lots of great artists and has lots of commercial choruses and melodies. I definitely would not describe my new album as hip-hop, although there are elements of that on it. I'm very proud of the new album and I think you'll enjoy it whether you'e gay or not, and if you like rap or not. There's something for everyone.

Where do you stand on the whole 'music download' thing?

If you really support and like an artist, then you should want to pay for their art. To download songs for free is stealing and while we all do it at times, I personally always use iTunes to buy the song—if I cannot find it on-line only then do I then consider a free download. But I never download for free first and outright.

Especially the independent artists. We don't have a bunch of money and some record label behind us. You steal directly from us when you don't pay for our work, and that has a massive impact on our already smaller incomes. If these artist cannot afford to keep going or continue to make the music that you love so much that you are prepared to steal for it, then in effect you kill out that artist and limit their possibilities.

Does it still matter that you're an out gay artist as much as it did when you first started out?

I consider myself to be QBoy: artist/producer, not as a 'gay rapper', which was the hook for all the press I got when I first arrived on the scene 2002-2004. Back then, because of the way hip-hop was, there was more of a point to being openly gay and working in it. I don't feel my sexuality should always precede my job, and while it obviously still has an impact on the way I see my life and some of the things I write about in my lyrics, my sexuality is not the 'be all' of my work. That would be very boring indeed! I try to make good music everyone can enjoy whatever your background, but from an honest perspective, that's the best I can do.

Where will you be going from here? What's the big QBoy plan?

Well currently I'm back in the States to promote Moxie and the DVD release of the documentary I feature in, Pick Up The Mic, which is just out. Then I get back to London to perform at Pride in Trafalgar Square, which should be great. Then I have a gig in the Southbank Centre and over to Amsterdam. I am just working on pushing this new album and hopefully making some more music videos to follow the current one. Meanwhile, I am also putting together a non-QBoy side project which will be a dance album produced by me, but without me featuring vocally on any of the songs. The idea is to get other people to add their colour to the mix. That's sounding great so far—working with Queen Pen, a female rapper that features on that 'No Diggity' track by Blackstreet. I've already done an official electro house remix for Princess Superstar's new single 'Roc U' and I'm hoping to bring over DJ Spinderella from Salt-N-Pepa for my next PeaceOUT UK Festival in September. Should be fun!

SERGE DEVANT IS ONE OF THE MOST EXCITING NEW STARS TO EMERGE IN THE WORLD OF ELECTRONIC MUSIC IN THE PAST FEW YEARS.

Born in the former Soviet Union where he studied classical music, he's now living in Brooklyn, New York. He became the youngest resident DJ at New York's legendary Crobar and has picked up corporate sponsorship deals that many seasoned DJs and producers would give their right arm for.

He caught my attention last year when He caught my attention last year when remixes of his version of The Beloved's 'Sweet Harmony' were causing a riot on the dance floor. Then came his second single, the mesmerizing 'Addicted' with its atmospheric, deep beats and beautiful vocals from Hadley and it was obvious he was no flash-in-the-pan. I caught up with Serge last month, just days before the release of his debut album "Wanderer".

You must be excited about the release of your new album.

Yes, it is pretty exciting to see something you have worked on for such a long time to see the light of day and get lots of great feedback. That's one of the main rewards after spending so much time working on it.

Can you describe the album?

Well when I sat down to start working on the tracks, there was no particular genre I had in mind. Of course the singles are going to be dance records but in general I wanted this album to be a sort of a journey in music, different genres and moods, but most importantly I wanted to have good songs!

...and where did the album title come from?

Making this album was a journey for me, searching for my sound, and I think a listener will also be taken on a journey when they listen to the album from beginning to end. So "Wanderer" was a perfect name for it I thought.

One voice really stands out for me on your album and that's Hadley who provides the vocals for my 2 favourite tracks, 'Addicted' and the title track. Yes, Hadley is quite amazing. I discovered her on MySpace actually! When I started working on the album I posted a blog and after digging through loads of profiles and voices, I stumbled upon her. She ended up living just 10 minutes away...so we got together and magic happened!

You left Russia at 16, do you get a chance to return to Russia often?

Well, I'm actually going there in the next few weeks for a gig – the scene there is actually pretty good. There are a bunch of clubs, some cool after-hours places, it's a good place. People go out there and even with this crisis that's going on in the country at the moment - they are pretty enthusiastic about going out and listening to their favourite. Dls, which for me is the most important thing.

When are you visiting the UK next? I played for The Gallery at Turnmills and again at Ministry of Sound - so I've been there few times. Definitely looking forward to coming back and rocking it again though!

'Cevin Fisher's Big Freak', or better known as 'The Freaks Come Out' and 'You Got Me Burning Up!' featuring Loleatta Holloway's mega-diva vocals stripped-out from the classic 1980 hit 'Love Sensation'.

Jason Guy caught up with Cevin on the eve The Freaks Come Out 10th Anniversary release.

l really can't believe it's been 10 years since 'Freaks' was released. Did you have any idea it would be so huge?

I knew the remixes would do well, just because we had a wide range of quality remixers involved. And as the mixes we're turned in, I was blown away with each one. They just kept getting better and better... and that they themselves we're inspired big time by the original mix too!

Does is still command a regular place I your sets? I imagine a lot of people expect you to play it.

Yeah I get request for "The Freaks Come Out" all the time - it makes me feel good on that level. Someone always wants to hear "Freaks" wherever I go. I've been playing the Sharp Boys mix as well as The Trancetters mix for years now since before the 2009 mixes came along too, as well as the Original Mix of course.

How much input did you have choosing the remixes this time round? The Prok and Fitch remix is outstanding.

As far as choosing the remixers, I would have to give all the credit to my label bosses over at Subversive, Martin & Martin - they did an excellent job choosing the remixers. They're spot on point and the best in the game. What more can I say about Prok & Fitch... their work pretty much speaks for itself.

Who or what caught your attention at this year's WMC?

I was impressed with the drive and the hustle. I was also totally impressed with the job that Pacha NVC did, as well as the Ultra Festival and the Beatport Parties. It was good to see all of the DJs doing it up as well. Totally awesome seeing Danny Tenaglia, Louie Vega, Erick Morillo, Carl Cox again. There was SO much going on!

You presented the award for Best International DJ which was won by Armin van Buuren. Did the best man win? (My vote would have been to Axwell)

Yeah it was awesome presenting the award for Best Intl. DJ! I would have to believe in the polls and they voted for Armin Van Buuren and that's the way it goes. I was super-curious though, and I in fact thought for sure I'd be presenting to Tiesto. >>>>>

For me it's all about trying to bring the energy wherever I play, it's always a challenge, but I LOVE it.

I know they were many years ago, but can you describe just how wild Whitney Houston's all night & day parties used to be?

Well, at the time I was in my early teens, and just the fact that I would get to play long sets of all different types of music and just being around some really **and** cool people dancing and just having a great time made the parties come off as being wild - I didn't even drink at the time

This was during her clean-cut "I Wanna Dance With Somebody" days? This was back around the time when she was a model for Seventeen Magazine , and I used to date her best friend's sister! - This was definitely pre-Super Star Whitney Houston days

So Avenue Q has survived the credit crunch and has moved theatres, how has that been?

It's great. It's a stunning, beautiful new theatre and of course we're all very excited to have jobs as we didn't close. It was weird at first. I mean, I had nine weeks off with the move, so my body just relaxed, now I have to get used to having my arms up the back of two men (laughs) so to speak. For anyone who hasn't seen the show, they're puppets I'm working, and it's quite tough on my arms. At first I came off stage sometimes wondering where I was. We are also one of the cheapest shows (laughs) not in that way... tickets... we are cheap and wonderfully cheerful.

What made you want to do a show like 'Any Dream Will Do'?

Well, it was a musical that I loved, I had always wanted to be Joseph and I hadn't worked for a few years so I thought 'why not'. I was aware it was a TV show and could be good for my profile. In all honesty I didn't think I would make it through the first round. It could easily have backfired and actually been detrimental to my career, thankfully that wasn't the case.

How was it after you were voted off?

Hard, really gutting, but also in a way there was a huge amount of pressure behind that show, which suddenly wasn't there. I think me being the 'shock evictee' if you will, has actually helped, it's made me more determined and made me sure this is what I want to do.

You have always been open about being gay...

Did you know that on 'Any Dream Will Do'? They told us (the BBC) that we should keep our sexuality a secret as it would put off voters and the viewing public. I was quite shocked that people would be bothered and there were quite a few gay guys on that show, plus you have the very out and lovely Graham Norton. I have always been open about my sexuality, so it was difficult. I would just say "No, I don't have a girlfriend"... I didn't want to lie to anyone.

Maybe they thought some dirt would come out about you?

(Laughs) There isn't... much! (Laughs) Actually they did call me in the office once as one paper was going to run a story that one of the contestants had been a male escort... and they wondered if it was me. Secretly, I was quite shocked and appalled... and flattered.

Has being openly out and a well known face helped on the boyfriend front?

(Laughs). People come up to me and talk to me a lot more, which is lovely, as I love meeting new people. At the same time I think it stops some people talking to you as they might think you're a bit uppity. Has it helped? I am not sure really, no one has asked me that before.

How did you get the Avenue Q gig?

Before 'Any Dream Will Do' I had already auditioned for a part and had got through a few stages but not into the actual show because the cast didn't change. Then after Sweeney Todd I auditioned again and got the part. I was so thrilled because I am a huge fan of the show and it has so much heart to it. I cried the first time I saw it because I could really relate to some of the puppets (laughs). I sound so daft. People think I got it through the 'Any Dream...' but I didn't... I had a fair few rejections after Joseph you know.

Is singing with a puppet hard?

Do you know what, you have to go to puppet school and it is really hard at first. In most auditions they hand you a song or a song sheet, in this one they just hand you a puppet and watch what you do... it's quite disconcerting. Being two puppets is great because I have always said singing is my thing but in this show I have to act both characters. It's been a learning curve but has shown me there is more I want to do.

Now that you are the headline act have you become a diva?

(Laughs) I hope not! I don't demand puppies in my dressing room; in fact I don't demand anything. My new dressing room is great though... it's got a bed in it, not that I need a bed (laughs) well you never know. Is there more pressure? Not really as I don't think of myself as a headline name. I still see pictures of myself on the adverts on the tube and get a shock. For me the show is all about a whole team, there isn't one star, we are all very much behind each other... laughing at each other when we forget our lines.

You have also released your own album...

And I funded it myself. Seeing that amount of money leaving my bank account was the scariest thing, but I really wanted to do it. I had the opportunity to fulfil a dream...so I thought 'sod it' and it's doing really well. It's a collection of all my favourite songs (laughs). No Simon, not 'Spice Up Your Life, though doing a jazz version of a Spice Girls song could be quite cool, maybe on the next one. It's all songs I have loved, some are pop, some are forgotten, some are from musicals... it's a nice mix.

What would you like to do next?

I want to play Elphaba in Wicked, but I don't think that that's going to happen. I would like to do some TV work or some musical film, or just a film. I was John Barrowman's 'special guest' on his last tour and the buzz from an audience like that was amazing. There are lots and lots more that I want to do... it's endless.

Yes, there are quite a few. They've really stuck with me, which is good... they've really kept me out there. I mean, buying the calendars and stuff... they've had a real big impact on the jobs I get as well... and I don't think they realise it. They have got me many gigs... so a big THANK YOU to all my gay fans.

Despite his varied career the one area that he wasn't expecting a call-up from was... to appear in a musical. "When they came up with the offer I said to my agent -Why are you agreeing to this you know I can't sing." Not a very auspicious start for either Phil or the production and things only got worse. "I went down to the rehearsal studios and I thought 'Whoa'... it was like Fame Academy... leg warmers and stuff and I thought Oh my God what have I let myself in for. They gave me a song to sing and I've never sung in front of anyone but my showerhead before. Afterwards I walked away from the audition saying never ever again."

Regardless of Phil's own doubts, he was offered the part and with the encouragement of his manager took on the role of Dirty Harry... the sort of Gary Barlow character, in the show. "Once I started rehearsals I thought this was the worst decision I'd ever made in my life. Multi award winner Karen Bruce was the choreographer and it was just so hard... and if you've never danced before it's like teaching a brick how to swim."

That initial introduction to the world of musicals was a bit of a revelation for Phil and he begged his agent to try to get him out of his contract.

"I called my agent up and told he had to get me out of this. The producers said they would give me extra tuition and training so, I stayed behind an extra 2 hours every night. Then in the last week of rehearsals, I got one routine right and after the rest of the cast gave me a round of applause... I thought... yes... I can do this. His loud laugh at the prospect really gave me the reply I needed but then he added... possibly jokingly and just before he was whisked off to his next interview... "Never say never"

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GMFA, the gay men's health charity, has announced the next dates for its highly successful stop smoking course for gay men in London. The courses are free to attend and the next two will start on 14 July and 6 August, each consisting of one evening session per week for seven weeks. Since they first began in 2001, nearly 1,000 gay men have attended the sessions, which have consistently achieved a higher success rate than the standard NHS courses. Gay men have many shared experiences of smoking. The reasons we start smoking are often similar - such as wanting to belong to a group, to rebel, or to socialise on the gay scene - and, equally, there are common barriers to quitting. Unlike sessions designed for generic groups, there is the opportunity to share these experiences to help you understand your smoking habits and to support you through the process of giving up. A new study by the online dating service gay-PARSHIP has revealed that no longer do straight women have a monopoly on the gay best friend -- as portrayed in Will & Grace, Sex and the City and Brothers and Sisters. Apparently straight men want one too! Famous straight/gay pairings include David Walliams and Matt Lucas, and Justin Lee Collins and Alan Carr - but now it looks like there now aren't enough gay men to go round! According to the survey of 1,300 British singles by gay-PARSHIP - the gay arm of Europe's largest premium online matchmaker - nearly a third of straight men (29%) said they'd like to expand their social network to include a platonic gay best friend: 25% would like a friendship with a gay man and 32% with a lesbian. At present just one in ten straight men can count a gay man or woman as a good friend, with less than one in 100 claiming more than two close gay friends. THE NORMAL RESERVATIONS ABOUT WHO WE FANCY SEEM TO DISAPPEAR AT THE DEPARTURE GATE AND ALL TOO OFTEN THE BOY WE ORDINARILY WOULDN'T LOOK TWICE AT BECOMES PART OF THE HOLIDAY EXPERIENCE.

Does this sound familiar? Well before the memory of a night of sangriafuelled passion is put in the file marked 'experience', it is worth remembering that an estimated 10% of the British population under 25 carries a sexually transmitted infection (STI) so if you have unprotected sex, there is every chance that you will wake up with a medical condition rather more serious than just a crashing hangover. And here's the worst bit - you often don't know if you have been unlucky as many STI's don't have any symptoms! No-one is thrilled by a trip to the doctor and returning to work after your summer

holidays means that time off can be difficult. Fortunately the advent of online services such as www.theSTIclinic.com means that you can be tested and treated remotely, at your convenience. Online clinics work on the basis of 'Request,

Receive, Respond, Relax: Visitors to the site can be tested for between one and seven specific infections, including Chlamydia, Gonorrhoea and Herpes. They register to receive a test kit, based on giving a urine sample, which you complete and post back to the clinic. The results are given out in a couple of working days.

LEGAL OULSTIDA

We are a couple in our 50's, we are in a Civil Partnership and we own our own house. The mortgage is paid and we are just about to re-write our new Wills. What is the best way to word the Will to get the most satisfactory outcome from Death Duty should one of us die before the other? The house is the main asset in our partnership.

Says Karen Witter, associate at Davis Blank Furniss:

Whether inheritance tax is payable or not usually depends on the value of the estate left behind by the person who has died. Every person is allowed to leave a set amount on death without tax being payable, this is called the 'nil rate band'. The nil rate band for 2009/2010 is £325,000. Any gifts you have made in the last seven vears before your death (over and above £3,000 per year) will also be put towards the nil rate band however. Assuming that you are going to leave your entire estates to each other and have not made any lifetime gifts, there will not be any inheritance tax payable on the first death as gifts between

civil partners or spouses are inheritance tax exempt (subject to some foreign exceptions). The first partner to die will therefore not have used their nil rate band. When the second partner dies, they will have their even and the head but in

will have their own nil rate band bút in addition, the law allows the estate to claim back the nil rate band of the first partner. Thus the nil rate band of the second partner is increased by 100%. On today's figures then, if your joint estate is worth £650,000 or less, no inheritance tax will be payable on either death.

If you do have additional assets, you could consider making small lifetime gifts of £3,000 per year or less to reduce the value of your estates, or speak to a specialist about other methods of lifetime tax planning.

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Getting Around

Many important buildings are located in Paris' suburbs, including the Stade de France, but the city's trains, buses and trams, as well as the availability of taxis, makes travel easy if not always quick.

The Place de la Bastille is within walking distance of Notre Dame cathedral and Le Marais, which is the trendy Right Bank district where many of the city's gay locals can be found. Museums, creperies, restaurants and parks are all nearby, as are shops and the Palais du Justice.

The Champs-Elysées sports many of the big shopping names and is also the place to check out Claridge's and some fine restaurants. The Champs-Elysées also connects the Concorde withg the Napoleonic Arc de Triomphe.

Avenue Montaigne, next to the Champs-Elysées, is the place to be for luxury fashion: Louis Vuitton, Givenchy, Dior and Chanel.

Near Place de la Concorde, at the other end of the Champs-Elysées, are the Hotel de Crillon, Hotel Ritz and Hotel de Vendom, as well as famous jewellery and fashion labels such as Cartier.

Montmartre is full of swanky cafes and art galleries, and the Avenue de l'Opera has the capital's biggest concentration of department stores. Here can be found the Galleries Lafayette grands magasins and most of the major banks. The area is worth a visit just for the opulent Napoleonic architecture alone.

Finally, Ab Fab fans should visit Faubourg Saint-Homore, Paris ´aute-couture district, to check out Christian Lacroix and Hermes.

Thing to do

Paris offers lots to do, which can be a problem for short weekend breaks. However, hopping on one of the tour buses is an easy option. Tickets cost about 20€ and are valid for two days. It means you don't have to rely on public transport, as the buses go from Notre Dame, next to gayhub Le Marais, to the Champs-Elysées, to the Eiffel Tower, and back. You can hop on and off at whim and if you plug your headphones in, they even give you all the history bits too!

For romantics, head to Café Anthracite. This recently opened, gay-owned venture is a stylish cafe-bar secreted away from the main drag of gay bars in Le Marais. The menu is a sophisticated blend of elegant, classic French cuisine and lavishly prepared contemporary dishes. Start with pink Veueve Clicquot for a warm-up, then try the foie gras as a decadent and flavoursome starter, perhaps accompanied with some delicious licquorice wine. The steaks are all melt-in-the-mouth delicacies suitable for the main course, and the waiter can recommend a perfect red wine to accompany the dish.

Desserts are varied, although the chocolate cake with molten chocolate centre was a delicious conclusion to a filling meal.

Randy royal raver Prince Regent escaped London back in the 1770s. Though straight - and no port or sailors here - he brought with him an air of flamboyance and devil-may-care that made the town a natural colony for rich queers in tow. The word got out and in time thousands flocked to a pleasant place by a Southern sea scarce an hour from London but seemingly a million miles away.

Yet it is only with legality in recent decades that a visible gay quarter has emerged: around St James Street and Old Steine, stretching along the front from the Palace Pier into the area called Kemptown, or "Camptown" as now truly is.

The Bulldog Tavern (31 St James Street; T 01273 684 097), on St James Street itself, is the oldest gay venue in town still functioning. An exmorgue, it's used to stiffs of all kinds and is rightly renowned for being a community hub. The Marine Tavern (13 Broad St; T: 01273 681 284), just off on Broad Street, joins a crowd of other traditional Kemptown bars that generally cater for the older crowd.

Or try the all-in-one Amsterdam (11-12 Marine Parade; T: 01273 688825) on the seafront - a hotel-bar-sauna multiplex which pulls in travellers from afar who strangely fancy everything under one roof. To rev up, the Queen's Arms (7 George Street; T: 01273 696 873) - over on George Street across St James' - is still one of the campest pubs in town with regular drag acts and karaoke, for a drunken cheery crowd.

R-Bar (7 Marine Parade; T: 01273 608 133) ups the style stakes with unbeatable views of pier and sea. Almost next door, Charles Street (8 Marine Parade; T: 01273 624 091) - something like the Soho Rupert Street Bar but bigger - is the real style-meister hereabouts, with room for 500, many of whom you'll find queuing at the long bar, if not busy making a big entrance or exit down the illuminated ramp. Also pop into Vavoom (31 Old Steine; T: 01273 603010) round the corner.

There are several main devotedly-gay clubs in Brighton, each offering varied nightly flavours to suit most tastes. Legends (31-34 Marine Parade; T: 01273 624462) is a vast multi-million-pound-refurbished bar-club-hotel combo-complex, right on Brighton's seafront. Revenge (32 Old Steine; www.revenge.co.uk) is just about the biggest club in the south of England outside London – not that we want to compare ourselves with that place do we boys? – playing to a young, mainstream crowd across multi-floors; vying with a host of regular rival nights – not least Popstarz (@ Ghetto, 129 St James's Street; www.popstarz. org), every Friday, from 9.30pm, and the massive Wild Fruit (@ Tru, West Street; www.wildfruit.co.uk).

If you still need to let off steam - or get restless after Sunday lunch - The Denmark (86 Denmark Villas, Hove; 01273 723 733) near Hove train station is a buzzing "male health" complex in town.

On a sunny day West Beach between the two piers is the obvious place to bare nearly all. But more fun by far is the official, male-dominated nudist beach about a ten minute jaunt along the front towards the marina. And just back from said beach are the infamous Duke's Mound bushes. As ever, beware.

Uniquely cosmopolitan amongst British seaside resorts, Brighton is a kind of mini London-on-sea, with none of your Blackpool tat! And amidst a quintessentially English backdrop of mile upon mile of aquapastel promenade paint and a ghostly, burnt-out West Pier moored offshore against the blinding sun – G-A-Y truly runs through its soul as through a sticky pink six inch stick of candy rock.

FACTOR MATH

WORKING IN THE FITNESS INDUSTRY AND BEING A PERSONAL TRAINER FOR THE PAST TEN YEARS, I'VE BEEN ASKED EVERY QUESTION YOU CAN POSSIBLY THINK OF. MOST OF THESE QUESTIONS ARE THE RESULTS OF "FITNESS MYTHS" PEOPLE HAVE HEARD OR BOUGHT INTO, AND MANY OF THESE MYTHS ARE CAUSING YOU TO TRAIN INEFFICIENTLY AND ARE ROBBING YOU OF VALUABLE RESULTS.

So instead of beating your head against a wall trying to tone up and slim down, let's tackle some of those common myths together so you can achieve the body you desire.

*Myth: I want to lose fat and gain muscle, so I'll just do cardio to lose fat and once I've lost my fat I'll do weight lifting.

Truth: That's good you started to exercise but there is a much more effective way to do it. When you just do cardio your body does lose fat but is also burns muscle. When you start losing muscle your metabolism slows down making fat loss even harder.

Try this. You can focus more on cardio but still include at least two to three 30 to 45-minute weight training sessions per week. I recommend circuit training or using a lot of super sets—that way you can work more muscle in less time and keep your heart rate up. Then after a few months, once you've lost your desired amount of fat without losing any muscle, you can shift to more weight training and less cardio. It's that simple.

*Myth: Machines are for toning and free weights are for building muscle mass.

Truth: You can build muscle mass and tone with both free weights and machines. The difference is that free weights generally produce faster results because they are more natural and therefore recruit more muscle fibres. Whether you build muscle or just "tone" has more to do with nutrition and the workout program you are on.

*Myth: To build muscle mass, increase the weight.

Truth: Heavy lifting will produce faster strength gains but for most people it will not mean more muscle. Studies, and even personal experience, have shown that a medium rep range, between eight to 12 reps, produces the greatest gains in muscle size for most people. This has a lot to do with the different energy sources you body uses and the different muscle fibre types. Since variety is the key to training you should still do high reps, 13-25 reps, and heavy reps, two to seven reps, but about 50 percent of your training should be in the medium rep range.

*Myth: Do leg raises to work the lower abs and crunches to work the upper abs.

Truth: The problem is most people don't know what/ where the lower and upper abs are. The so-called "upper abs" are over the rib cage and the "lower abs" are what make a six-pack (they start around your sternum and go down to your pelvis area). Yes, your sixpack is one muscle. If you don't believe me try flexing just the upper part without flexing the lower part. You can't because they are connected. Most good abdominal exercises work both the lower

exercises work both the lower and upper abs. Obviously when you raise your legs compared to your body it works then from a different angle, but it still works them.

*Myth: You have to do "cardio" at a fat burn heart rate (HR) to most effectively lose fat. Truth: You're burning fat right now as you read this, just not that much. As long as your body is using oxygen, you're

burning fat to some degree, and as long as you're alive you're using oxygen. It's true that when you are in a "fat loss HR" (generally 65 percent of your maximum heart rate), you burn a greater percentage of fat compared to sugar (carbs). But at a higher heart rate—80 percent —you burn more calories overall, plus you've increased your metabolism to high levels so your body will burn more calories over the next several hours.

What's a person to do? When in doubt, do both, at least when it comes to cardio. Interval training is a form of cardio where you go at a higher HR for a period of time then you slow down and go at the lower HR for a period of time. You can switch back and forth as much as you'd like. Whichever of the three you choose to do ir consistently and you will see fat loss progress.
