

MANCUNIA LAUNCHES IN THE GAY VILLAGE

When gay superclub Essential closed two months ago it created a bit of a vacuum in Manchester's thriving Gay Village. All the old favourite haunts were still there - Cruz, AXM, Poptastic they all have their own crowd - but where would everyone visiting The Village go now the flagship gay venue had closed?

That question was well and truly answered when Mancunia opened its doors a few weeks back. It's in the old Essential venue so it's obviously as big as the old club but the place has been brought bang up to date with a state-of-the-art sound system and lasers and futuristic décor that's as 3D as the latest Hollywood blockbuster!!

The biggest change to the venue is that courtesy of a great big hole on the middle floor, you can now see what's going on downstairs - this floor, formerly "The Main Arena" in Essential, is now "The Pop Arena" playing pop and party anthems. The big Manchester DJ's playing the upfront vocal house that Essential was known for are still in attendance but they are now upstairs in a fantastic new room called "The Dance Studio"

Former owner of Essential Nigel Martin-Smith is still involved with the new club and a lot of the staff and deejays from Essential are still working in Mancunia and this has resulted in some people in The Gay Village claiming that the whole thing is just a publicity stunt. Nigel had this to say "When I first announced that I was selling Essential I had every intention of doing just that. Then the customers demanded a closing party and 2000 people turned up and I was blown away. Just as I realised how many people still loved the place the buyer started haggling about the price so I told him to sod off! A brand new company was formed and I took on a partner as I haven't got

as much time to spend on the new venue. Obviously some of the staff and entertainers from Essential have been retained because they're the best in The Village! We've spent a huge amount of money doing it up and I know some people are moaning but I really don't know what the problem is. Whether it's Essential or Mancunia the fact is we are investing in The Village and giving everyone a new safe place to go clubbing once again".

Mancunia has launched a new Friday night called "Hotpants" featuring muscle boy dancers and male strippers in The Pop Arena and Old Skool classics in The Studio. As a special launch offer they are doing buy one get one free on all drinks between 11pm - 1am and admission is just £3.

Saturday events at Mancunia vary from week to week. Expect big name visiting deejays and club brands. Admission on Saturdays is now £5 before 12 and £8 after and the buy one get one free drinks offers is from 11pm to midnight


EXHIBITION FOR LBGT ARTISTS

'Pride in the House' grew out of the Mardi Gras Arts Festival at Lauderdale in 2002, celebrating gay and lesbian artistic talent. Eight years later it is an annual fixture, an important part of our programme and a chance for us to be part of London's celebration of Pride. The competition is open to all professional artists from the LGBT community. Three are selected to take part in a group show. An overall winner, who has a solo show later in the year, is announced at the private view.

They're not specifically looking for 'gay' subject matter although previous winners have included Mike Thorn's portraits of large hairy men, Kobi Israel's photos of beautiful boys and the celebration of the female body by Veronique Maria.

This year the parade starts a weekend of celebrations in and around Birmingham's gay village on 29th&30th May



In the USA, Adam Lambert is very well known. Last year he took part in American Idol, the country's highest rating TV event and was placed a very creditable second. His vocal gymnastics added a certain style, drama and dynamics, which quite literally left both the judges and the viewing public speechless. He should have won. Even the winner, Kris Allen, thought he should have won saying; "Adam deserved this." He went on to explain this remark. "He was the most consistent person all year. He was seriously one of the most gifted performers that I've ever met."

Why did he fail to capture that elusive winners tag? It could have been because of an interview he did where he quite happily explained that he was gay. Eeek! Whereas, in the UK when Will Young came out it didn't make any difference, in the US it was thought that his coming out, and images of him kissing his boyfriend that were widely circulated, might have had a disastrous effect on the population's desire to vote for him.


Adam himself seemed to take it very philosophically and not be too perturbed about how things turned out. A natural performer, Adam had been on the stage since the age of ten and had sang and toured in various plays and musicals in the US and in Europe. His decision to appear on American Idol apparently came after he spent a few days at a festival enjoying the effects of those naughty, psychedelic mushrooms one reads about. Having gained his position on the show he set about choosing and interpreting songs in his own unique way. In the final, when he sang one of Queen's classic numbers alongside Brian May playing guitar, such was the power he brought to the song, it was rumoured he was being lined up to front the band.

At the American Music Awards he performed the title track of his new album "For Your Entertainment" and courted controversy. The performance showed Lambert kissing a male keyboardist, grinding a dancer's head against his pelvis, and grabbing the

crotch of another. The conservative viewer's groups were incandescent with rage branding him immoral and perverse. Lambert told Rolling Stone magazine, "Female performers have been doing this for years—pushing the envelope about sexuality—and the minute a man does it, everybody freaks out."

Thankfully, we can now experience what all the fuss is about with the UK release this month of his album. With his out-of-this-world vocal range and unique musical style, Adam Lambert is the ultra-glam, rock superstar that will have us all hooked. The record garnered contributions from such innovative artists as Lady Gaga, P!nk, Muse, Justin Hawkins (formerly of The Darkness) and Rivers Cuomo of Weezer. Brilliantly produced and a rock/pop mix that shows off his incredible vocals... it is a clever, classic debut album and one that should see the same success here as it has already achieved in the States.

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

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TAKING TO THE STREETS



Street Dance 3D is set to revolutionise cinema's this summer with the first full action 3D film to be made in Britain. Street Dance has been popular in other parts of the world but, with the success of talent show winners like Diversity, Flawless and George Sampson, Britain has finally proved it has street talent of its own. The movie sees an urban dance crew forced to partner up with ballet dancers from the Royal Dance School to utilise their facilities in order to win the Street Dance Championship and the this spectacular dance routines are sure to wow audiences across the country.

D'relle has been dancing and teaching Street Dance as well as other dance styles since the age of 13. He has taught choreography for many successful crews and since deciding dance was the path he wanted to take he has worked with a long list of famous choreographers, dancers and artists including Lavelle Smith Jr (Michael Jackson, Janet Jackson and Beyonce), Kimberlee Jay (Nike, Madonna) as well as Jamelia and Chris Brown. However, despite D'relle's success one question Bent wanted to ask was: "Does being gay in a supposedly 'macho' world of

'attitude'.. have an impact on other people's response to the way you dance?

I think years ago when I first came out it did, a gay dancer in this hip-hop culture wasn't really heard of. However, I didn't let it stop what I had to do, I just made sure I was still a strong contender and can represent as a dancer. Making people think about my talent first. Nowadays there is more tolerance because there is a large LBG community in the dance scene whether people want to admit it or not... it's there.

What do you think of the up-surge in street dance?

I think it's great that dance is now being taken seriously by the world and more people are discovering a passion for the art.

Who do you think is responsible for it?

Street Dance has always been seen as a big thing in places like Sweden, Paris and America. It was only a matter of time before the UK saw how much people were actually waiting for it to become big over here.

Some of the UK troops are brilliant and

innovative but are we lagging behind other countries?

There are UK troops such as Plague, Flawless, Definitives, A.G, Boy Blue and Unity that I believe have moved us closer to other countries if not surpassed some of them.

What did you do before you became a street dancer?

My answer is always the same. There was no 'Before'. When I discovered dance it was like running in an open space and feeling unrestricted and free. It was the way I dealt with a lot of things in my life, through dance and choreography.

D'relle is now currently working on his new two crews, a mixed troupe and the other all girls. He will be competing with some of the members from his crew in NYC this year.

IN A TRANCE

Dave Pearce is one of the UK's most in demand DJs and has sold over 1 million albums in the UK. TRACK REVIEW TOP TRACKS OF THE MONTH



EDEI - In My Bed Remixes (Label TBC)
The first time I had this track, just one word came to mind... Freakshow. If you're pining for the Manchester club night as much as I am, then good news - it's back as from June this year and expect this to be played at the re-launch night! High-powered, super-charged, feel-good house with the catchiest, feel-good lyrics going. The track is taken from Londoner Ede's first album (she's even borrowed Mary J. Blige's backing vocalists don't you know!). Both the more commercial Dave Aude, and the more techy Full Intention mixes do the trick for me!




SUZANNE PALMER - Big Love (Star 69 Records)
Yes... the vocal is back. Known to most as Pete Heller's Big Love, originally a huge hit back in the late 90s, New York based Peter Rauhofer drags the track screaming into 2010. This street-smart update, re-sung by diva Suzanne Palmer, gives it a new lease of life and a cool set of New York-styled mixes. Etienne Osborne & Peter Brown lead the charge, with equally addictive creations from Muzzaik and Peter Rauhofer adding further weight to a track that was on many WMC Miami playlists. Altogether now - "I've been saving my loving..."



LOVERUSH UK! FT SHELLEY HARLAND - Different World 2010 (Loverush Digital)
Loverush UK! follow up their UK no.1 club anthem, 'Give Me Love', with 'Different World', another superb slice of progressive vocal trance, designed to seriously move the dancefloor. This time they team up with Shelley Harland, the voice behind Delerium. First seeing the light of day on Loverush Digital, the guys behind the track agreed this catchy, feel good tune deserved another shot and began planning a new dancefloor assault. The 2010 mix from Loverush UK! breathes new life into the track with a beautifully produced song and has already been crowned Gaydar-Radio's Big Tune Of The Week. The remix package is on its way. Style of Eye **Out: 17th May**



IT'S ALL NON- STOP FOR ANDY

He's one half of Britpop's legendary duos, Erasure and, together with keyboard player Vince Clarke has produced over 13 successful albums and achieved well over 30 hit singles. Andy Bell, the man with one of the most iconic singing voices in music, has now branched out to produce his second solo album... Non-Stop... and what a belter it is. A lavish, lustrous, sumptuous collection of deluxe dance-pop, seductive electro anthems and gold-plated disco grooves... Bent wondered why the need for new horizons?

It all started really back in 2007, when we were out in America on the first True Colors Tour as Erasure... it was put together by Cindi Lauper; it's a charity she has over there for Human Rights... and we were trying to get Obama elected. We'd been doing Erasure for 21 years, touring, and albums and I said to Vince: "I really hope you don't mind but I'd like a break from Erasure for a couple of years or so" and he said fine. I wanted to do some work with other people, Stephen Haig, John Collier, Pascal Gabriel... do some stuff from scratch. With all the writing and production it took about a year in total.

You sound a bit different on these tracks...

I just needed to have a breather and see what else was going on. Spread my wings, live my life a little. This is like a different character that people don't know me as. I wouldn't say I'm a club kid, but I do love hearing remixes and club tunes. The album is quite robotic, quite tongue in cheek, lots of synths and glamorous disco. I can't get Madonna out of my head, and I sort of feel like: if she can do that why can't I?

Will you be taking this on the road?

I'm doing a few gigs. I'm doing a big one for Mencap at the 02 but it's an 80s thing so, I won't be doing any new songs, they want Erasure material. I am doing some DJing where they want me to do some PAs as well, one in Gran Canaria, 6 weeks in America in June and July but if anything comes up, I'm willing to do them.

The DJing... that is something about your life I wasn't aware of...

Well, it isn't really a main thing but (he laughs) I can't do anything else apart from music. However, we are doing a new Erasure album, which will be out next year. We were going to tour this year but with this album (Non-Stop) we thought it might all be a bit much really.

Is this going down the Boy George route with DJing as another talent?

Not really because music has always been my hobby. When I'm not Erasuring or doing solo stuff, I'm always looking out for like dance tunes, buying stuff on iTunes and things... I've got a huge record collection. I used to go to all the 'electro nights' like 'Nag Nag Nag' and 'The Cock'... places like that, so I thought it would be really nice to be able to play this kind of music. I got a few gigs playing around London, a few pubs and things, then I got a DJ agent in New York and played some gigs over there... so it's a hobby really... that pays my air fare.

One track on your album 'Touch' talks about your reluctance to appear on reality shows, what have you been asked to do?

Big Brother and Celebrity in the Jungle (ha-ha) which I just wouldn't be able to do at all.

Were you insulted at being asked?

Not really... but the thing is though... it is so hard to get on the TV anyway now. We're lucky to get a Graham Norton or Loose Women and things like that but otherwise, unless you are on one of those shows you can't get on to anything else. They are wanting you to

make a fool of yourself before they'll have you on anything else and I just think, well, I don't want to do that. To me the music is more important.

Ahhh but I could see you on Masterchef...

That would be Vince, he's really an amazing cook. I've only ever made Vince dinner once, and that was in the early days of Erasure and it was a disaster, we didn't eat until after midnight. Never again.

How do you feel about the Simon Cowell approach to talent?

He's on to a winning formula and I quite admire the guy but for me it's just a bit formulaic, which I'm not saying I wouldn't go on if I was a new young singer, but it is a bit like a turnstile.

With Erasure you are known for your outlandish outfits... do you still enjoy the 'frocking up' aspect of performing?

Well, not so much the frocking up but one thing I'd like to do is... look like an Amsterdam hooker in her window.

You did a musical a while back is there a chance of you doing any more? I could see you as Dorothy in the new TV production of Over the Rainbow?

(Laughs) Thanks! Well, I would love to do a musical. I have a friend in New York who says he'd love me to do anything but it is just time, at the moment I'm too busy but I'd love to. I'm totally open to the idea though not necessarily Chicago.

Is that because it has been done to death by 'pop' stars?

Yes, but I wouldn't mind being in Phantom of the Opera... so when that comes on the TV... looking for a new lead... maybe I'll go up for that one.

Back in 2004 you publicly announced you were HIV+ how is your health these days?

In general I'm OK. When I'm on tour... if there are any bugs going round, usually it's the crew that gets it but then, I'm bound to get it. People don't realise it's hard singing when you've got the flu but because of all the insurance and letting people down, you can't cancel it. You have to do it, which often compounds the problem. We've done about 750 gigs and only postponed about 6 or 7. So that's not bad going really.

There's a single being released prior to the album, what can you tell me about this first piece of new material people will hear from you?

Call On Me is going to be the next single, which I'm really pleased about. It's a really simple song, and the backing vocal riff was inspired by Diana Ross singing 'Ain't No Mountain High Enough'. It's really about my friends in New York, they're from the East Village. When I see them we just go and hang out in some of the more grimy bars.

From the album I can see 'Subject/Object' being one of the gay boys favourite shouting out the words across the dancefloor.

(Laughs) You may well be correct but maybe DHDQ - aka Debbie Harry Drag Queen - a high-camp homage to the empress of New Wave New York and her armies of imitators, I was on the True Colors tour with Debbie and she's lovely. She loves the drag queens as well... to me, nobody's ever copied her because they can't, she's the queen of all of them.



talk about. That's why for years now we've tuned in time and time again to see what our country has to offer, even if we have sometimes had to witness a deadly defeat.



1. Eurovision was the idea of Marcel Besancon the Swiss head of the new European Broadcasting Union (EBU) back in 1956

2. The 'la la la' trade mark of many Eurovision entries is the result of the first winner, Lys Assia of Switzerland, forgetting her words on her reprise of the winning song.

3. The first UK entry into the song contest 'All' by Patricia Bredin (1957) at 1'50" remains the shortest song ever heard in the competition's history.

4. 1958 produced the most successful song from the competition even though it didn't actually win. Italy's 'Nel Blu Dipinto Di Blu' rated only third but was renamed 'Volare' and hit the top spot in the US Billboard charts and went on to become a worldwide success.

5. In 1968 Spain won the contest with a song that consisted of the repeated lyric 'La, la, la' pipping the UK's Cliff Richard's 'Congratulations' into second place. Since then many conspiracy theories concerning Spain's dictator Franco who it was claimed had somehow nobbled the judges.

6. In 1969 four songs won giving the organisers a bit of a nervous breakdown. The following year the rules were changed and it was decreed that should the scores be even again, the song with the highest rating individual scores would win the competition.



7. In 1988 French/Canadian songstress Celine Dion won the contest with 'Ne Partez Pas Sans Moi' representing Switzerland.

8. Transsexual Dana International won for Israel in 1998 with her heartfelt song 'Diva'. The conservative religious leaders of the country were horrified that such a person should represent the nation and the following year when she accidentally tripped and fell on her entry onto the stage, many thought it was an assassination attempt.

9. Only 17 countries have scored 'nul points' (or zero to me and you) although some have managed this feat on more than one occasion. In 2003, the UK joined that not-so-happy band when Jemini's 'Cry Baby' didn't impress... anyone.

10. The Eurovision throws up all styles of music from heavy metal to ballads and folk music to the campiest of camp disco. It remains, for many gay fans, the highlight of the year... topping even the latest Madonna or Lady GaGa release.

THE TATTOO TABOO

Why is it that some gay men simply cannot get enough of tattoos and why do others feel the need to have them to define their masculinity? Why do some men only date men with tattoos and why do others avoid them at all costs? Simon Savidge went to meet up with tattoo virgins, tattoo addicts and tattooists to discuss the great ink debate.

I have one friend who has been telling me forever that I should "...go and get some ink done", as if it's a kind of gay initiation rite that I simply have to partake in. True, there are many gay men I have known, and dated that have been tattooed but is it really a gay thing? Do we all think that inked skin is the sexiest thing ever?

According to some men that is precisely how they think.

For Dan, a committed lover of this particular body fashion. "I wouldn't date someone w h o

hadn't been inked". He didn't say why particularly other than it was a turn off. Meanwhile, there are lots of fetishists that will only date someone whose body glistens with images, words or designs, so I suppose he's not going to go without. There has been a rather large increase in 'homemade' tattoos, which mixes pain and disfigurement and seems to take it too far and I'm sure that not every gay man on earth will drop their pants at the sight of a rather crude tattoo... for Malcolm it's a bit of a turn off: "They believe I should be impressed that they are a 'work of art... yer sure!". Some people are dedicated about them, but I suspect most get tattooed as a fashion, and will regret them in the future but won't be able to eradicate them. Occasionally you get a nice distinctive one, but usually they're just generic and ugly. I find the whole idea of covering your skin with designs bizarre - it seems to be making claims - "I'm edgy" - and that by implication, those without are banal and unadventurous. Personally I prefer people that express their personality through their words and actions rather than telegraphing it through inked-on designs. It's as if having invested money and pain in getting one, they feel obliged to keep the thing on show. I'm aware how prim and sanctimonious that sounds but let's be honest... it's not always individual, often it's just a bit ugly. And what about when you start to sag? I have a mate who is now in his late 50s. When he was young he had a nice tattoo of a dolphin etched onto his bum cheek. For many years he was very happy with it but now, as his ass sags, he complains it looks more like a beached whale.

Some folks choice of tattoos leaves a lot to be desired. I was once dating a guy and we got naked for the first time where I discovered that he had Snow Whites and the Seven Dwarfs happily 'Hi-Hoing' up his legs... and that was that game over. It was the first and last time we ever got naked together, I just couldn't stand the thought of his love of Disney going to such extremes. Interestingly enough, Disney characters are some of the most popular tattoos that British public request.

Some think that having your name tattooed on their person is the height of dedication, love and romance, in reality, according to a gay tattooist I met, its not as easy as you might think to have someone's name engraved on you permanently. "Some of us refuse to tattoo partner's names unless they have been married for about 20 years and we may actually ask you for proof. I am not joking." He goes on with the reasoning for this. "There is a saying in the tattoo business that if you get someone's name tattooed on you, you will shortly split up. We call it 'the curse of the needle.'" (Ask Cheryl and Ashley Cole if this is true)

There is another reason to avoid some of those magical foreign symbols and words - you don't always know what they mean. How many times have we heard of the guy with a wonderful tattoo in Persian or

Chinese, thinking it was the name of their partner or some other magical symbol... only to find out later it actually means 'Toilet' or 'Dumbass' in the original language? I suppose this type of thing can be just 'urban legend' but it does make you wonder.

The popularity in people getting tattoos is on the increase. Pop fashion, sexy footballers and the plethora of really artistic tattoos has seen the upsurge in 'walking art' hit an all time high. For some a tattoo has other



connotations: The numbers etched on prisoners in the concentration camps, the membership tattoo of many criminal groups, not forgetting the simple prejudice of people who are frightened by 'difference'.

I suppose in some cultures tattoos are very masculine and indeed part of the way of

saying who you are, having said that I am far too much of a big girl to have had it done myself. Having your skin indelibly stamped is a huge decision and one that shouldn't be at the whim of fashion. However, I have to admit that some of the images I have seen are fantastic... though obviously not on me... and I must applaud the sheer artistry and talent of those tattooists. Some of the big 'ideas' can take many months to complete and some areas of the body are more sensitive than others... you might like to check on your pain threshold before deciding where the needle starts its work. Some tattoos are just plain strange. Denny in Liverpool said; "I met a guy who had 'fuck' tattooed on his bottom lip and wanted me to bite on it. I was not unduly surprised when he said he was unemployed." I have heard that they can be quite addictive. I remember Marc Almond once saying that he just started with a small tattoo but now, in some ways, he uses his body as a canvas - adding ideas and images as and when.

Then I wonder... is there a competitive element to body tattoos? Paul, who admits to loving the idea of a 'nice Celtic Cross' but is now having second thoughts says: "I know someone with a tattoo of an upside crucifix made out of cocks on his leg. How do you top that or know where to start, and where does it all end?" At what point does the image stop being just an image but the major part of your personality? How extreme is extreme? Some of the facial tattoos are just plain scary but is the reason for this a complete sublimation of who you are... creating someone... or something... completely new?





A TOUCH TOO MUCH?

Recently I had friends from London and Brighton staying with me in Yorkshire, so I took them out for a day in the historic city of York.

One of the couples is young and very much in love. They're relationship is still new and they couldn't stop holding hands and kissing in public. Hardly anyone in York paid them attention. I saw one or two people nudging each other and pointing. A young guy said to an old guy; 'Did you see that? They were kissing. That's what it's all about these days.'

When we came to Leeds it was a different story though. Lots of people were pointing and I was shocked that a city as cosmopolitan as Leeds doesn't appear to be as open and accepting as in other places.

With all the TV soaps and their constant gay storylines, you'd think that a couple of boys holding hands (as girls don't seem to attract the same horror) would create much of a stir at all. Is it because it is such a rare thing to happen? Is it just the sheer novelty of the occasion that attracts the whispers and the pointing. Maybe, but often from these whispers there is a more sinister undertone that is very disquieting.

I know a gay couple who have been partners for over 33 years and, unless under very gay circumstances, never hold hands in the street. They might kiss hello or goodbye in the car, but as for public displays of affection, it's a definite no-no. When I ask them why, they point to the fact that they don't need any trouble at their age.

It got me thinking about how more gay people should be expressing their love and friendship of each other and we should have an official day for holding hands.



When I looked into it further, I discovered there's already an international hand holding day which starts in January and runs throughout the year (www.adayinhand.com). On this day, week, month or year, same-sex couples and friends all over the world are encouraged to hold hands in public to support the visibility of LGBT people.

Also, Sshh! Saturdays, which occur on the last Saturday of every month is a way of encouraging and inspiring LGBT people to take responsibility for their equality and live their lives without fear or restraint. Sshh! Saturdays in major Western cities will, it is hoped, become regarded as an important time when numerous same-sex couples can feel confident in holding hands and being themselves.

Celebrities Brian Paddick and Boy George, author Paul Burston, MEP Michael Cashman, (the original Eastender gay boy) and activists Peter Tatchell & Cleve Jones (Harvey Milk's aide) have already endorsed the campaign.

Last Valentine's Day, students in Oxford formed a same-sex chain around the Radcliffe Camera, in celebration of friendship and gay rights. Instead of a boy-girl line, the participants held hands in boy-boy, girl-girl formation. But I know what you're saying, it's easy for students, they have nothing to lose. That might be so, but we can't rely on Outrage and Stonewall or a few students to do all the work for us... sometimes, even in a small way, we need express our own feelings... and to feel less oppressed in our own country.

If you feel the same way, why not join the Kiss-In for Global Queer Freedom, which takes place at 2pm on Sunday 9 May, in Piccadilly Circus, London. They need hundreds of couples to join in.

This will be a re-enactment of the iconic OutRage! Kiss-In from the eighties and celebrates the 20th anniversary of the queer rights group OutRage! It was originally staged to protest against the arrest of same-sex couples for kissing and cuddling, and shamed and embarrassed the Metropolitan Police into ceasing to arrest LGBT couples for displays of affection.

This time the Kiss-In is focused on demanding freedom and human rights for LGBT people worldwide, especially in countries like Jamaica, Iran, Uganda, Malawi, Nigeria, Iraq and Saudi Arabia but it is also good for all of us to be visible.

LIVING IN THE GAYTRIX

74% Of Gay And Bisexual Men Would Refuse A Straight Pill

Borrowing the concept from the science fiction film *The Matrix*, over 2,500 gay and bisexual men were given the choice: Take the blue pill, the story ends, and you wake up heterosexual. Or take the red pill and you remain in *The Gaytrix*. The statistics revealed that 3 in 4 of those surveyed would refuse to take a pill to change their sexuality.

In a recent survey conducted by the free gay dating website ManCentral.com, members were asked if they would take a pill to change their sexual orientation.

Whilst 26% of those surveyed admitted that they would take a 'straight pill', if such a pill existed, almost three times as many men (74%) had no desire to alter their sexual preference and chose to reject any such 'cure'.

Considering the improved attitudes towards homosexuality in today's society, it may be assumed that younger males would be less inclined to covet heterosexuality than those who grew up in a less accepting social climates. However, males aged between 18 and 24 were the most likely to take a pill to change their orientation (37%), this gradually fell to just 13% of those aged 51 to 60.

Consequently, it seems that for the majority of gay and bisexual men, society bears little impact on the individual, whilst self-acceptance develops with age. On the other hand, younger males are more likely to feel anxious to conform to the norm, which may contribute to the higher percentage of 18-24 year olds willing to take a straight pill.

The survey also found that:

16% of openly gay and bisexual men admitted they would take a pill to change the sexual preference, whilst more than double the amount (38%) of closeted men would accept the altering drug.

Gay men were the most likely to refuse a 'cure' with 79% unwilling to change their sexuality; compared to 66% of bisexual men and 54% of bi-curious males.

Though 1 in 4 of the men surveyed would take a pill to become straight, the research highlights that the majority of gay, bisexual and bi-curious men have no desire to leave *The Gaytrix*. www.ManCentral.com



METHADRONE – THE CHANGE IN THE LAW

A big hit in clubs across the UK and regarded by many as safe because until recently it was seen as a 'legal high'.

The main derivative of Cathinone, a naturally occurring stimulant found in the khat plant and cathinones is the name given to a group of drugs that are 'cousins' of amphetamine-like compounds that include amphetamine itself (speed), cocaine and MDMA (ecstasy). These cathinone derivatives were previously sold online and in headshops as so called 'legal highs'. Cathinone derivatives include a variety of chemical compounds with slang names including:

Mephedrone. (aka 4-MMC; 4-methylmethcathinone and MCAT). A stimulant drug with effects similar to amphetamines (speed) and MDMA (ecstasy) producing euphoria, alertness, talkativeness and feelings of empathy. It can also cause anxiety and paranoid states and risk overstimulating the heart and circulation, and overstimulating the nervous system to cause fits. Evidence suggests that mephedrone may cause death.

From the 16th April 2010, the entire 'family' of cathinone derivatives became controlled as Class B drugs. This means they are illegal to possess, give away or sell. Possession can get you up to five years in jail. Supplying someone else, including your friends, can get you up to fourteen years in jail and an unlimited fine.

GAY SEX FOR THE CLUELESS

Most gay guys think they know everything there is to know about sex...but actually is there a lot more to learn? The latest issue of FS magazine from GMFA, the gay men's health charity, gives you a wealth of information if you are clueless about sex, and some handy pointers if you're not.

The article will help you get clued up about your cock, sucking, fucking, your arse, STIs and HIV, GU clinics, and sex, drugs and alcohol. There's a whole host of information that most of us were never told about in school, including:

> Your cock contains some of the most sensitive areas of your body. That's why it's so much fun to fool around with.

> STIs like HIV can get into your body through your cock. The areas that let viruses in are the opening you wee through, your foreskin and the head.

> Catching HIV from sucking cock is relatively rare. However, both partners can catch gonorrhoea, syphilis, herpes or Chlamydia from blow-jobs.

> The lining of your arse is like a sponge that soaks up liquid, including spunk if you get fucked without a condom and the guy cums inside you. That's why the arse is so vulnerable to infections like HIV.

> The route up your arse is not a straight line – there is a bend in it. That's why certain sexual positions feel better than others.


TRY SOMETHING DIFFERENT

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


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SIMON SAYS...


Dear Dan

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
